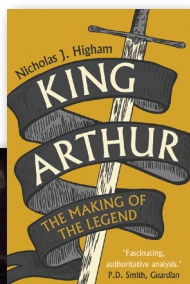
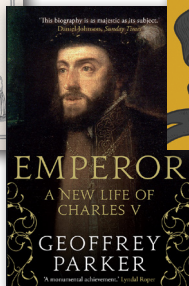
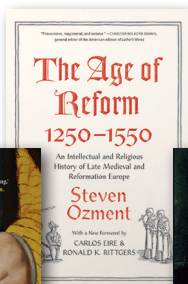
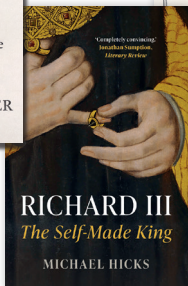
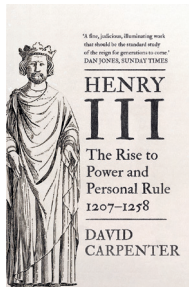
GOING TO CHURCH IN MEDIEVAL ENGLAND
