# International Medieval Congress

## 01-04 July 2024

The International Medieval Congress (IMC) is the largest annual gathering of medievalists in Europe, focusing upon all aspects of the Middle Ages (c. 300-1500).

IMC 2023 saw over 2,600 attendees attend the second hybrid-format IMC, with 86% of these attending in person. Now in its 31st year, IMC 2024 will take place in the University of Leeds campus, whilst retaining an option for virtual attendance for those unable to travel.

This year's Programme features medievalists from 60 countries, with over 2,000 individual papers, 680 academic sessions and a range of concerts, performances, round tables, excursions, bookfairs, and associated events. We expect to welcome 2,600 attendees to IMC 2024.
